An "award and acknowledgement of an important commitment made entirely in the spirit of the great bridge-builder and publicist Zelman," is how Ludwig explained it. #### AJC ACCESS: Breaking Boundaries: June 24 - July 1, 2013

At the invitation of **City Councilor Mailath-Pokorny** a delegation from **AJC ACCESS New York** was again travelling to Vienna this year. Founded in the year 1906, the **American Jewish Committee** is the oldest Jewish organisation in the USA. **ACCESS** is aimed at the **younger generation of AJC** (young professionals aged between 25 and 30).
